

2011 Constitution and Statute Changes

Article VIII, Section 3 – Dissolved Aerie/Auxiliary money can be used for any new Aerie/Auxiliary within the state (No longer needs to be in the same area).

Section 35.2 – States can now set up Regions, Zones and/or Districts

Section 35.3 – Now allows the State Aerie to give advice and counsel by request

Section 36.1 – On a new survey, only 25 have to be new or re-enrolled (25 dual members on the charter is now OK).

Section 62.1 – All 7 trial committee members must be present at the beginning of the trial.

62.3, a,b,c & d – Gives clear direction regarding replacement of trial committee members.

63.1 (b) – If the mediation process is successful, the \$25 filing fee is returned.

63.6 – Results of the trial committee can be in person (or by certified mail).

71.5 – Once dropped, must follow 70.17 to be re-enrolled.

82.1 (c) – Change wording from warrants drawn to the word “checks”.

82.1 (f) – The president is to see to it that the affiliation agreement is properly filed.

85.7 - Change wording from warrants drawn to the word “checks”.

86.2 - Change wording from warrants drawn to the word “checks”.

89.3 (h) – New section – Board of Trustees are to respond to all complaints within 30 days or explain why they have not acted.

116.1 – All internal unit by-laws must be sent to the Grand Aerie for record purposes only.

116.1 (a) – Membership dues in a internal unit cannot be paid in advance of the Aerie dues.

116.2 – Only the Aerie membership can approve changes to REAC By-Laws.

116.3 - Only the Aerie membership can approve changes to Under 35 Club By-Laws.

116.4 - Only the Aerie membership can approve changes to Past Presidents Club By-Laws.

116.5 - Only the Aerie membership can approve changes to Eagle Riders By-Laws.

Cobleskill's proposed law change to let 10 year treasurers to have the same status as PWP or 10 year secretary's was not approved this year.

The State Aerie proposed law change to allow the Grand Worthy President to appoint committee chairmen without the Board of Grand Trustees was defeated.
