**PROPOSED STATE AERIE BY-LAW CHANGE** FOE #2692 Depew/Lancaster at our last membership meeting voted to propose to amend section 2.4 of the N.Y.S. Bylaws. It now reads "No individual may cast more than five votes for or on behalf of any one Aerie in their capacity as a duly elected delegate from such Aerie". Additionally section 2.2 was changed to one vote for 50 members from one vote for 100 members. The cost to a larger Aerie to send the correct number of delegates to cover all the votes that they are entitled to would be prohibitive. As such, Aerie #2692 proposes to amend Section 2.4 to read as follows " No individual may cast more than 10 votes for or on behalf of any one Aerie in their capacity as a duly elected delegate from such Aerie". Fraternally, on behalf of FOE#2692, Depew – Lancaster, **Nick Polinski**, Secretary (Note, Last year we did change the New York State Aerie By-Laws allowing each Aerie to have one vote for each 50 members. That allowed the Aerie's with fewer than 50 members to have at least one vote at the same time giving all Aerie's more voting power in New York State. At that time we should have increased the number of votes one individual could carry to the State Convention for that Aerie. This amendment will correct that issue).

So successful a one was Doc, he was elected three more times by his fellow Adrian Eagles. He also served as Grand Worthy Secretary and Past Grand Worthy President. Doc passed away in 1988. Several years before his death he was diagnosed with kidney disease but persevered without complaint through long and painful dialysis treatments, never letting it get him down. The Eagles Doc Dunlap Kidney Fund is a fund to be used for kidney research in an effort to combat Kidney Disease. Its purpose is to raise funds and make grants to the universities; hospitals and other institutions involved in kidney research and related projects.
