Eagles soar toward century mark

The state's Fraternal Order of Eagles has spanned 10 decades, and the group's leadership is creating new projects to bring in younger participants.

The state Eagles celebrated their 100-year anniversary at 11 a.m. Sunday — exactly 100 years to the time and date the group organized in New York. The conference was held at the Depew-Lancaster Aerie Home, 4560 Broadway, Depew, with a visit by International Grand Worthy President John Potter of Priddis, Alberta, Canada.

"I think it's a wonderful, wonderful milestone," Potter said.

The event was part of the Eastern Regional Eagles Conference, which began Friday and included participants from as far away as Washington state.

The state Eagles held their first meeting Oct. 14, 1907, in Rochester, at the council chambers of city hall. The original 29 Eagle members were present at that meeting as then-International Grand Worthy President Theodore A. Bell presided.

Today, the state aerie has grown to more than 3,300 members in 32 cities. Keeping with the international motto of "People Helping People," the Eagles donate more than \$500,000 annually to local, state and national charities.

The state aerie has been home to several famous members, including former President Franklin D. Roosevelt. The women's auxiliary was instituted Aug. 8, 1961, in Rochester. During that first year, former First Lady Eleanor Roosevelt became the first woman to receive a life membership in the ladies' auxiliary in a special presentation in Hyde Park. Today, the auxiliary includes more than 3,400 members.

While the group has a rich history, Potter said memberships have declined. To attract new members and youths, the Eagles have created several new volunteer projects.

Potter's project for 2007-08 is the International Disaster Relief Program, a fund that aims to deliver immediate assistance during disasters. When the group is needed, a tractor trailer marked "The Fraternal Order of Eagles

Disaster Relief Unit" will be manned by volunteers and deliver food and water to affected areas.

Potter said the program follows other volunteer projects the group has designed, including those that help people with cancer, diabetes, and heart, spinal cord, kidney, Alzheimer's and Parkinson's disease; spread awareness about AIDS in chil-

dren; and support children of members who die while serving their country or at work.

"We have an absolute desire to help other people whenever we can," Potter said.

The international order was founded in 1896. The Eagles donate more than \$100 million annually to charities and individuals throughout the United States and Canada.

Donald Ianchunis, Eagles state president from Saratoga Springs, praised fellow members for the work they've done over the years and expressed hope for the next 100 years.

"I won't be here, but I hope there'll be relatives (here)," he said, "and I know the Fraternal Order of Eagles will be here."

There are other cardiovascular screening clinics that will charge you per screening about \$65 per test (Which is not covered under your medical insurance) or a flat rate of \$149 for three tests. The testing includes corroded artery screening, echogram of the heart and vasular screening of the legs.

GRANTS: (FAQ)

How can I receive a Universal Grant Form or know if an establishment qualifies?

Grant forms can be obtained from ww.foe.com along with the requirement sheets for all the funds.

Can Grants be submitted to an individual?

No, the Grand Aerie Charities are specifically established to provide grants for medical research, aging programs, child abuse, etc. The funds do not allow for benefits to a single individual. Typically the local Aerie or Auxiliary does a special event fundraiser to help the brother or sister in need.

Who does the Grant Check get sent to?

Each State is notified on how much in grant funds it has available for each of our charities for the coming year. This number is based on the State's previous year's general donations that were non-earmarked. Depending on the availability of funds it will be up to each State to decide which grants are approved. This year the New York State Aerie is scheduled to review any and all grants on January 19, 2008.

Remember to get your grant requests in by January 1, 2008.

Can Additional funds be requested with earmarked grants?

Yes, when requesting back additional funds, the donation check and grant request form must be sent to your State Executive Board. It will be the decision of the board to approve or deny the additional fund request.

CHARITIES:

Can one check be made out for all charities?

Yes. One check can be made out to the FOE Foundation. Please be sure to include a note or write on the check which fund(s) it is to be applied to such as Cancer, Kidney, MD, Jimmy Durante Children's Fund, Jimmy Durante Child Abuse Fund, Children's Aids, Diabetes, Spinal, Alzheimer's, Golden Eagle, Parkinson's or Circle of Life. One check can be written to FOE Memorial Foundation and under that fund is the HOME Fund.

Should checks be earmarked for a state project?

Yes. All checks for a state project (When that money is to be returned to that respective State) must be earmarked. The checks should be made out to the specific charity the State is requesting funds to be donated to and earmarked in the memo section of the check for "State Project".

How should checks for the GWP or GMP project be made out?
