Dear, NYS Secretary and By-Laws Committee

Proposed 2008 New York State Aerie By-Law Change.

From Section 2.4

Section 1.2 Between the annual sessions of the State Aerie, all regular elected or legally appointed officers and Membership Director of the New York State Aerie shall act as the Executive Committee and shall, subject to the laws of order, have and exercise all powers of the said State Aerie whenever the necessity of exercising such powers arises or where, because of an emergency, an annual meeting cannot be held.

A majority of the Executive Committee shall be necessary to constitute a quorum for transaction of business and the acts of the majority of the board members at a meeting, when a quorum is present, shall be the acts of the Executive Committee, However, if two thirds of the members shall, after all board members are notified, consent on writing to any action to be taken by board, such action shall be as valid a board actions as though it had been authorized at a meeting of the board. The Secretary shall record such action in the Executive Board minutes, together with the written consent of the Executive Committee members, as though a meeting had been actually held and the action taken thereat.




