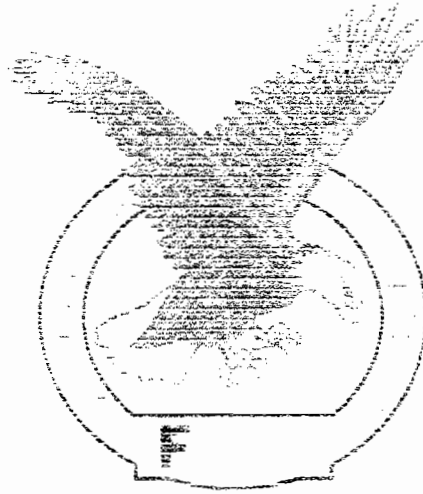
### WE NEED YOUR HELP:

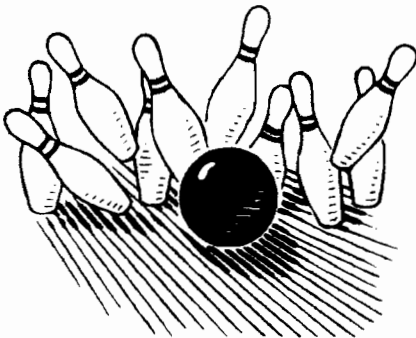
