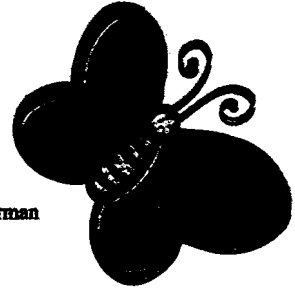

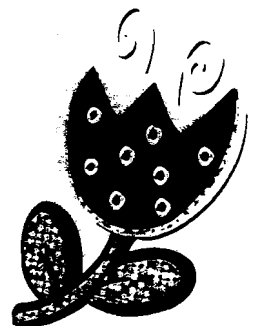
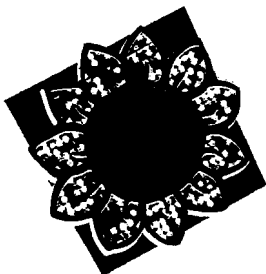
HERE'S A NOTE FROM YOUR MOTHER
