This weekend we will be in Depew/Lancaster to help them celebrate their special day. Hope to see many of you there.

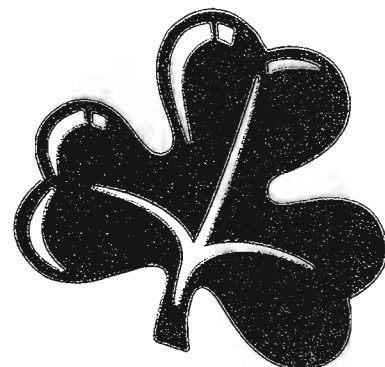
I'll leave you with this little poem:
