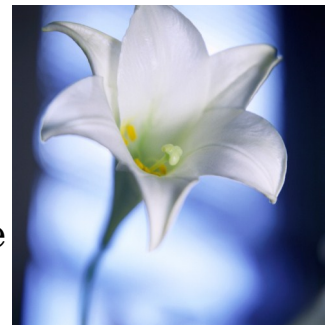
Eagles Monument Restoration Fundraiser
